**Introduction:**

This report analyzes the raw data regarding the Senior Exit Survey for the Bachelor of Education Program (B.Ed.) for the Academic year 2022-2023. The survey consisted of 43 multiple choice items as stated in Table 1 below.

- 6) Future plans

## 1) General Demographical Data

The data was collected from 289 students (male and female) enrolled in the Bachelor of Education program for the academic year 2022-2023 as indicated in Table 2. Most students indicated their parents or siblings had a degree from the University of Bahrain (72%) as shown in Table 3. The GPA average of the respondents was 3.28, where the maximum value was 3.66 and the lowest was 2.67.

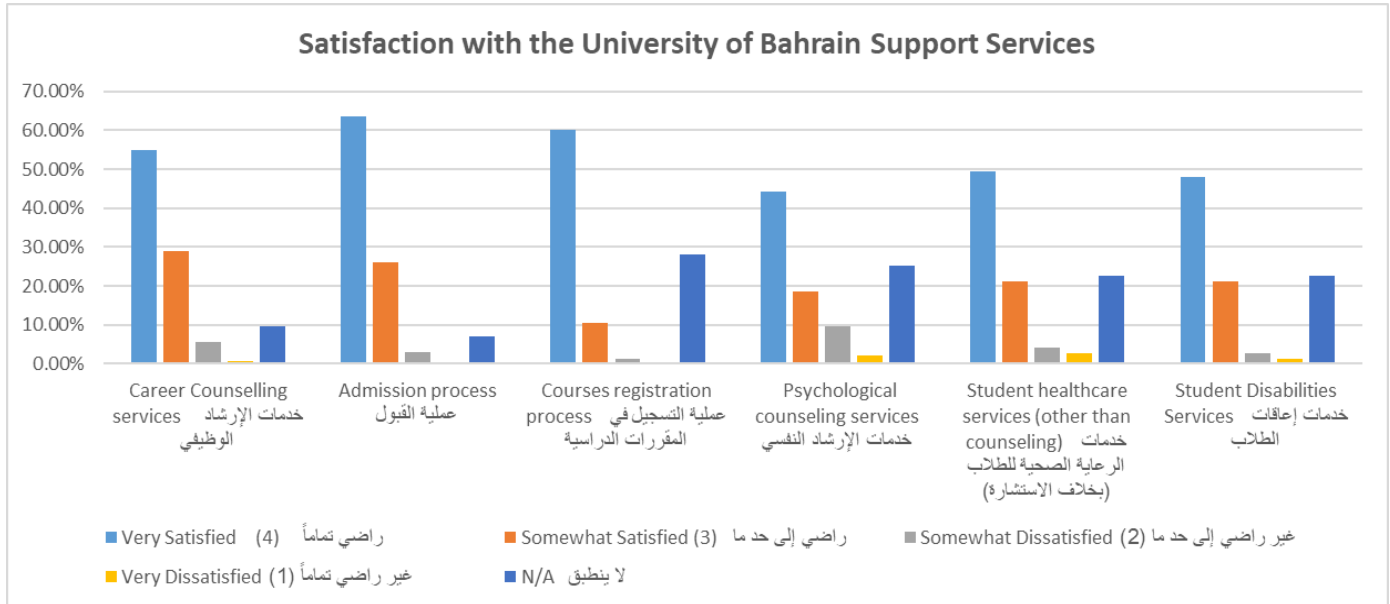

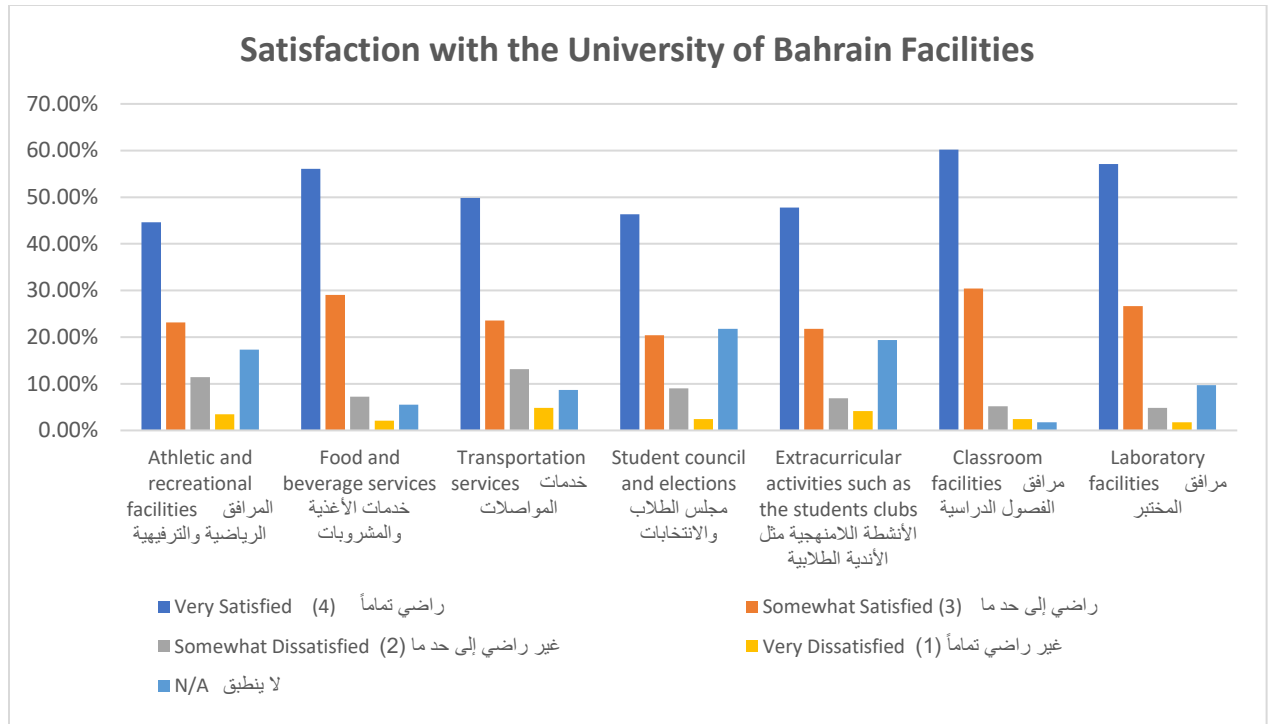
## 2) Satisfaction with the University of Bahrain Facilities and Support Services

The chart shows that the B.Ed. students were mostly satisfied with the Services provided where satisfaction levels were mostly between excellent and good (80-70%).

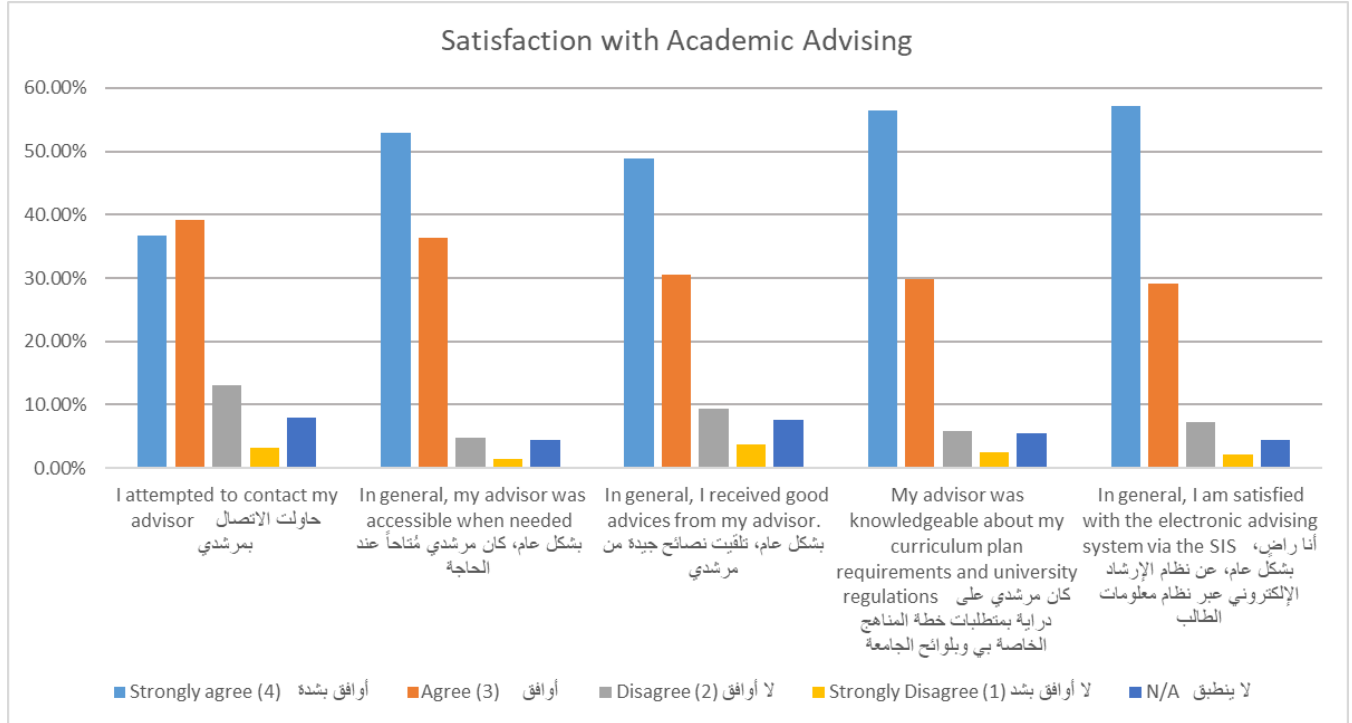


**Chart 2: Satisfaction with the University of Bahrain Facilities**

Chart 2 below outlines the students' satisfaction with the advising system.

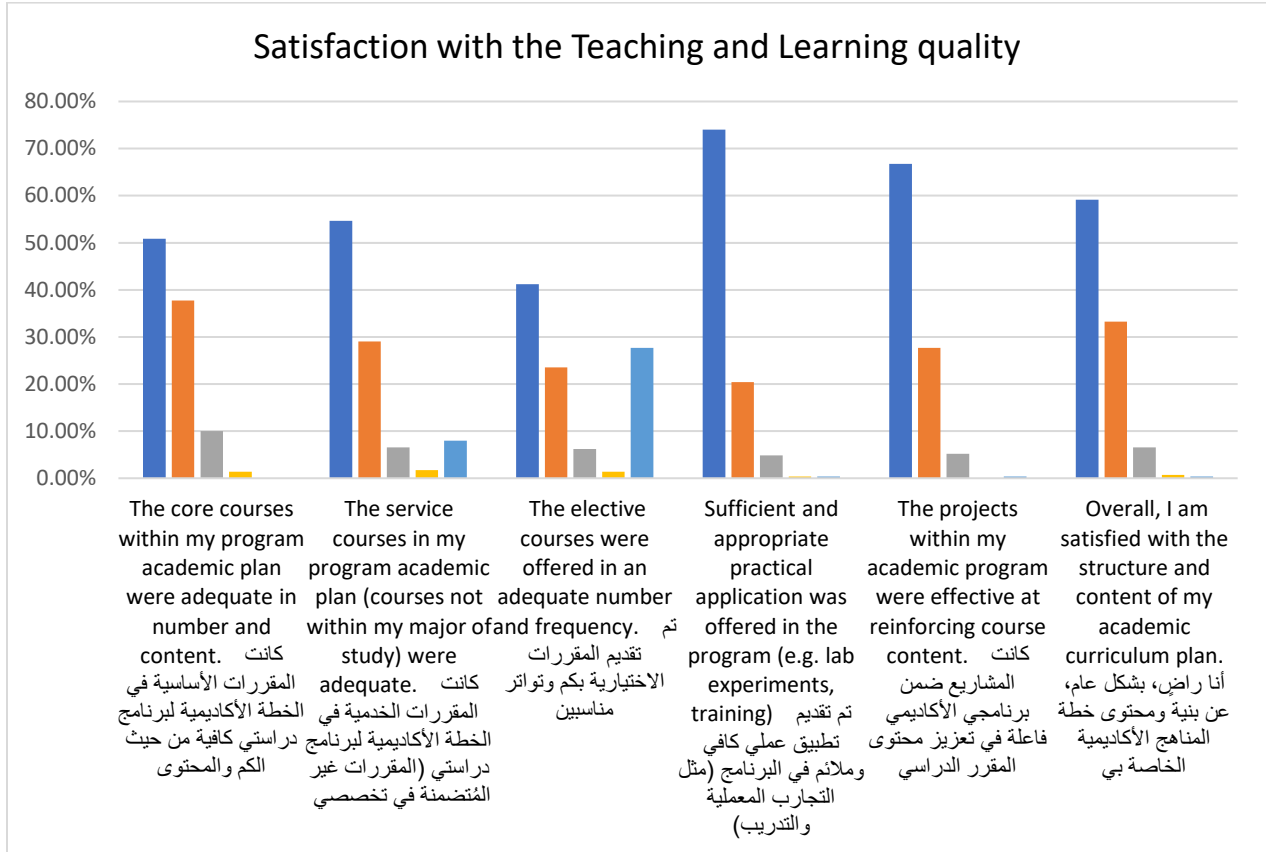


### Chart 3: Satisfaction with the Academic Advising

Chart 3 outlines the students' satisfaction with the program teaching and learning quality.

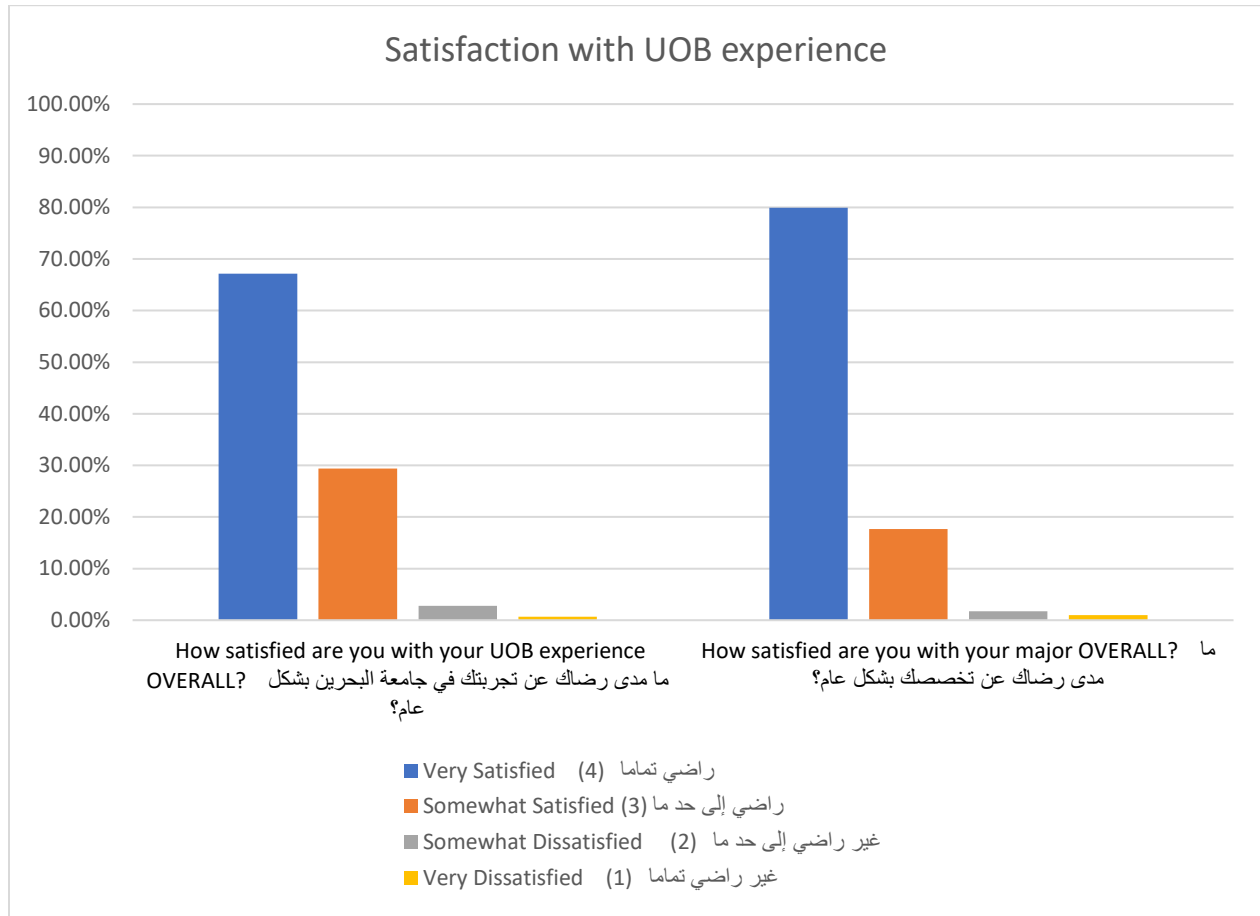


**Chart 4: Satisfaction with Teaching and Learning Quality**

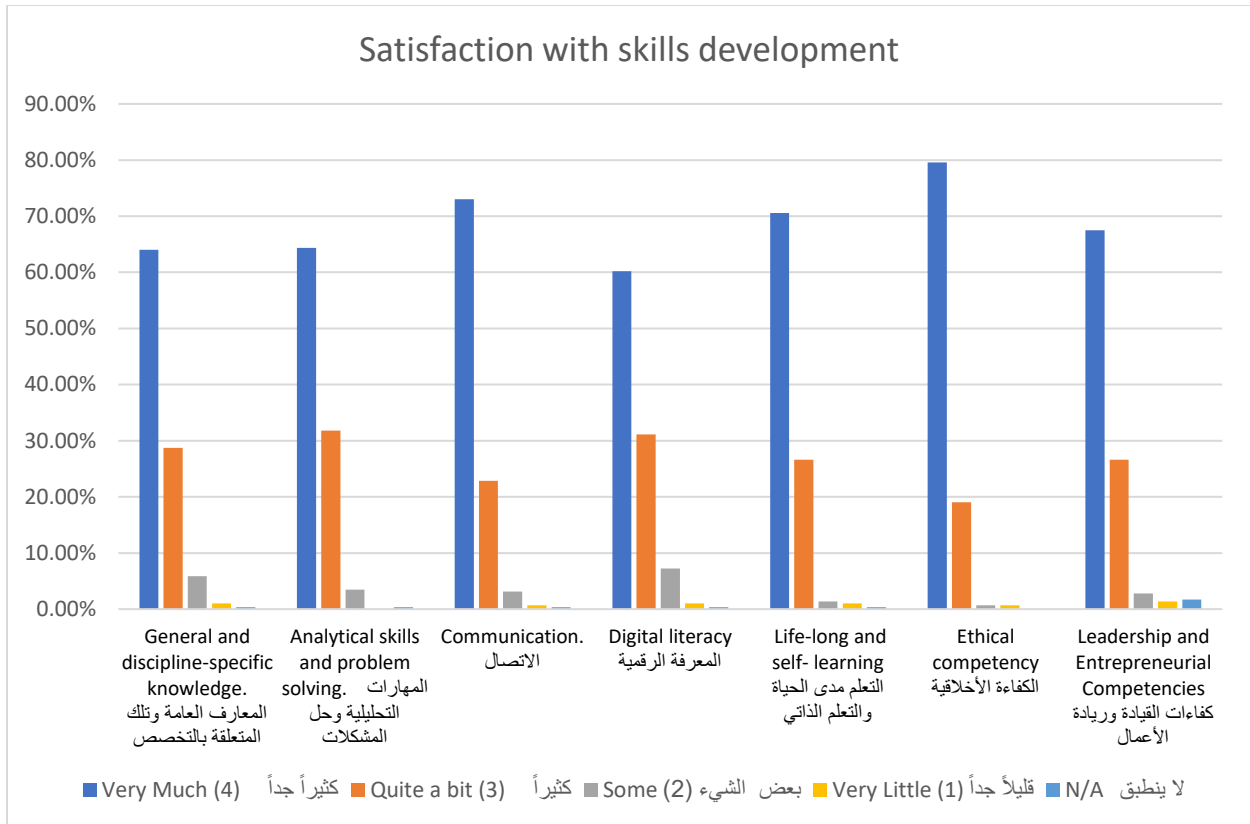
## 5) Satisfaction with the Overall UOB Experience

The above chart shows that most students (97%) found the experience at UOB satisfactory. Moreover, most students (96%) found their major satisfactory.

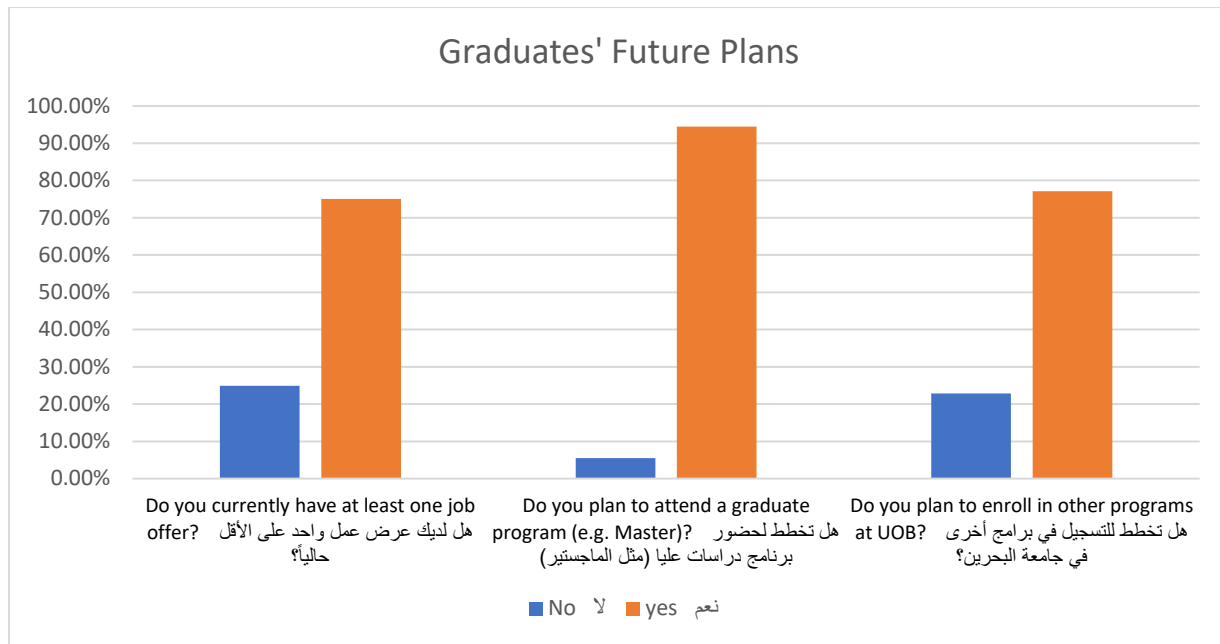


**Chart 6: Satisfaction with the skills development throughout the program**
